
## **GALÁPAGOS WATER**

## TEMPERATURE

- **Darwin & Wolf:** 20°C - 25°C (68°F - 77°F)
- **\* Isabela & Fernandina:** As low as 17°C (62.6°F)
  - **Highlight:** Only place to see **penguins** in the Americas' southern hemisphere!

#### 7mm wetsuits are standard.



#### **CURRENTS & MARINE LIFE**

#### **BEST TIME TO DIVE**



Year-Round Diving: Galápagos is always in season!

**December to May:** Warm waters & abundant hammerhead sharks.

June to November: Ideal for spotting giant whale sharks.

Weather: Two distinct seasons wet and dry, each with its own charm.

**Convergence of three major** currents:

- **Humboldt** (cold)
- **Panama** (mild & oxygen-rich)
- **Cromwell** (nutrient-rich)

**Result: Rich marine life** & some strong currents.
